In the matter of The Town and
Village Act,

And in the matter of an appli-
cation by the Village of Irma for
the annexation of certain lands to
the Village of Irma.

Upon the application of the Council of the Village of Irma, for an Order annexing to the Village certain outlying areas adjacent thereto; upon reading the Resolution of the Council and the other material filed, and upon hearing such persons as appeared before the Board at a public hearing at Irma, in the Province of Alberta, on Friday, the 6th day of September, 1946:

It is ordered, that the following outlying areas be annexed to the Village of Irma, in accordance with the provisions of Section 21 of The Town and Village Act (being Chapter 150 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1942):

Firstly All that portion of the north-east quarter of Section 28, Township 45, Range 9, west of the Fourth Meridian, described as follows

Commencing at an iron post planted in the east boundary of the said quarter section, 1,262 6 feet from the north-east corner thereof, thence following the said east boundary on an assumed bearing north a distance of 237 8 feet to a point, thence on a bearing of 72° 40' west a distance of 500 feet to a point, thence southerly and parallel to the east boundary of the said quarter section 237 8 feet to a point, thence south 72° 40' east a distance of 500 feet (more or less) to the point of commencement, containing 2 58 acres (more or less), excepting there-out 0 38 of an acre for a road, under Road Plan 219 E U

Secondly All that portion of the south-west quarter of Section 34, Township 45, Range 9, west of the Fourth Meridian, bounded as follows

On the west by the western boundary of the said quarter section, on the north by a line drawn parallel to and 726 feet perpendicularly distant northerly from the southern boundary of the said quarter section, on the east by a line drawn parallel to and 1,320 feet perpendicularly distant easterly from the west boundary of the said quarter section, and on the south by a line drawn parallel to and 66 feet perpendicularly distant northerly from the south boundary of the said quarter section, containing 20 acres (more or less)

This Order shall take effect as from the date of its publication in The *Alberta Gazette*.
