BEFORE:

The Board for Public Utility Commissioners for the Province of Alberta.

In the matter of "The Town and Village Act."

And in the matter of an application of the Village of Irma, in the Province for Alberta, for the annexation of certain adjacent property.

Upon the application of the Village of Irma; upon reading the consents of the owners of the properties concerned; upon reading the consent of the Municipal District of Wainwright No. 61; upon reading the other material filed.

It is ordered that the following lands be detached from the Municipal District of Wainwright No. 61, and that the same be and are hereby annexed to the Village of Irma.

**Firstly:** All that portion of the south-west quarter of section 34, township 45, range 9, west of the fourth meridian, in the Province of Alberta Containing 7.72 acres, more or less, as shown enclosed by a border colored orange on Filed Plan 2332 J Y

**Secondly.** All that portion of the road as shown on road plan 3749E T. in the said south-west quarter of section 34 which lies between the productions southerly of the east and west boundaries of the said parcel shown outlined in orange on Filed Plan 2332 J Y. Containing 0.77 of an acre, more or less

**Thirdly:** Parcel "B" containing 0.17 of an acre, more or less, and parcel "C" containing 0.44 of an acre, more or less, in the Townsite of Irma as shown on Filed Plan 6110H.W. (N E 28-45-9-4)

**Fourthly.** All that portion of the north-east quarter of section 28, township 45, range 9, west of the fourth meridian, in the said Province, described as follows

Commencing at a point on the east boundary of said quarter section 237.80 feet northerly from an iron post planted at a distance of 1262.60 feet from the north-east corner thereof said east boundary having an assumed bearing of north, thence north 72 degrees and 40 minutes west 500 feet to a point; thence northerly and parallel with the said eastern boundary 237.80 feet, more or less, to an iron post planted, thence on a bearing of south 72 degrees and 40 minutes east 500 feet, more or less, to an iron post planted, thence southerly along the said east boundary to the point of commencement Containing 2.58 acres, more or less.

**Fifthly.** All that portion of the original road allowance adjoining the east boundary of the said north-east quarter of section 28 which lies south of the production easterly of the northerly limit of the road as shown on Road Plan 219 E U Containing 2.20 acres, more or less.

**Sixthly:** All that portion of the said original road allowance adjoining the said north-east quarter of section 28 which lies north of the production easterly of the southerly boundary of the said portion described in certificate of title 17-U-144. Containing 1.55 acres, more or less

*Seventhly* All that portion of the original road allowance adjoining the east boundary of the south-east quarter of section 33 in the said township and range, which lies south of the production westerly of a line drawn parallel, to the south boundary of the said south-west quarter of section 34 and 726 feet perpendicularly distant northerly therefrom. Containing 1 10 acres, more or less.

Reserving unto Her Majesty all mines and minerals out of all the above described lands.

This order shall be effective as and from the 29th day of December, 1956.
