

Edmonton, Thursday, May 30th, 1912

The Hon. the Acting Minister of Municipal Affairs reports, under date of May 9th, 1912, that, having received satisfactory proof that the area mentioned hereunder is not contained within any incorporated City, Town or Rural Municipality, and that the said area contains not less than twenty-five occupied dwelling houses, he has, in accordance with the provisions of Section 3 of the Village Act, caused Notices to be posted in three conspicuous places within the said area, one of which was the Post Office, announcing the intention to establish the area as a Village at the expiration of thirty days from the date of posting such notices.

The Hon. the Acting Minister of Municipal Affairs further reports that such notices were posted at least thirty days prior to the date hereof.

Therefore, upon the recommendation of the Hon. the Acting Minister of Municipal Affairs, the Executive Council advises that, under the provisions of Section 4 of The Village Act, the North-West Quarter of Section twenty-seven (27), Township forty-five (45), Range nine (9)

West of the Fourth Meridian, be established a Village; that the Village be given the name of I R M A; and that Mr. Warren Blaine Peterson, of Irma, Alberta, be Returning Officer for the purpose of acting at the election of the first Council of the Village, and that the meeting for the nomination of candidates for the office of Councillors shall be held on Tuesday, the twenty-eighth day of May, 1912.

THE LIEUTENANT GOVERNOR IN COUNCIL.

The undersigned has the honor to report that having received satisfactory proof that the area mentioned hereunder is not contained within any incorporated City, Town or Rural Municipality, and that the said area contains not less than Twenty-five occupied dwelling-houses, he has, in accordance with the provisions of Section 3 of The Village Act, caused Notices to be posted in three conspicuous places within the said area, one of which was the Post Office, announcing the intention to establish the area as a Village at the expiration of Thirty days from the date of posting such Notices.
