MINISTERIAL ORDER

ERECTING THE VILLAGE OF RYCROFT

Whereas, the undersigned, being satisfied that all requirements with respect to the erection of a Village, under the provisions of The Town and Village Act (being Chapter 150 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1942), have been substantially complied with, it is hereby ordered that the area described hereunder, namely:

**Those portions of Section 16, Township 78, Range 5, west of the Sixth Meridian, in the Province of Alberta, described as follows**

**Firstly** The Northern Alberta Railway right-of-way and station grounds in River Lot 38, the roadway in River Lot 38 as shown on Plan 4763 C L ; that part of River Lot 38 lying between the southerly limits of the Northern Alberta Railway station grounds and a line drawn parallel to the said southerly limits and 66 feet perpendicularly distant therefrom

**Secondly** All of River Lot 39

**Thirdly** That part of River Lot 40 lying south of the northerly limit of the Northern Alberta Railway right-of-way

**Fourthly** The easterly 717 feet of River Lot 41 lying south of the northerly limit of the Northern Alberta Railway right-of-way, be, and it is hereby withdrawn from the Municipal District of Spirit River, No. 829, and erected into a Village, to be known as the Village of Rycroft.

It is further ordered, that a nomination meeting for the first election of a Council be held between the hours of 11 o'clock and 12 o'clock in the forenoon, on Monday, the 27th day of March, 1944, for the purpose of receiving names of candidates for the office of Councillors

It is further ordered, that Major R C Fitton, be, and he is hereby appointed to act as Returning Officer of the said nomination meeting, and that, if an election is necessary, it be held on Monday, the 3rd day of April, 1944, and that the said Major R C Fitton conduct the election in accordance with the provisions of The Town and Village Act in that behalf, and that, immediately after the result of the election is declared, the said Major R C Fitton report by registered letter to the Department of Municipal Affairs the names of the Councillors elected and their terms of office

It is further ordered, that the first meeting of the new Council be held on Wednesday, the 5th day of April, 1944

This order to be effective as on, and from, the date hereof.
