ORGANIZATION OF THE VILLAGE OF WILLINGDON

Notice is hereby given, in accordance with the provisions of The Village Act in that behalf, that, by order of the Minister of Municipal Affairs, dated the 31st day of August, 1928, the following area, namely:

All those portions of the north half of Section 11, Township 56, Range 15, west of the Fourth Meridian, which may be more particularly described as follows:

Firstly—All that portion subdivided under Plan No 380 E O.

Secondly—All that portion taken for station grounds and right-of-way, as shown on Plan No 496 E O

Thirdly—All those portions not included within the above plans, but indicated as the extension easterly and westerly of Railway Avenue as said avenue is shown on said Plan No. 380 E O

Fourthly—All that portion of the east half of the north-east quarter of Section 11 which lies to the north of the northerly boundary of the land taken for right-of-way, and to the south of the said production easterly of Railway Avenue; both plans being of record in the Land Titles Office for the North Alberta Land Registration District—withdrawn from the Municipal District of Eagle No. 545, was erected into a village, to be known by the name of the Village of Willingdon.
