

DRAFT Farming Operations Definition

“farming operations” means the raising and production of primary agricultural products and includes

- (i) livestock as defined in the Livestock and Livestock Products Act in a live condition,
- (ii) horticulture,
- (iii) aquaculture, and
- (iv) the operation of **woodlots** on a parcel of land for which an approved management plan has been prepared by a registered professional forester as defined in the Forestry Profession Act and implemented, solely authorizing the production of timber

on one or more parcels operated as a unit by a person who derives from the farming operation on that parcel or unit an **income sufficient to provide a livelihood.**

“income sufficient to provide a livelihood” means the level of income required by a person in order to qualify for farm vehicle licence plates.

“primary agricultural products” includes but is not limited to:

- (i) unprocessed and ungraded livestock products such as wool, fur, honey, eggs, milk,
- (ii) horticultural products that are sold in bulk or unpackaged lots, and
- (iii) products from woodlot operations when marketed in their raw, unprocessed state.
