

## **Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs)**

### **What is meant by the income requirement for a farming operation?**

To be considered a farm for the Alberta Farm Fuel benefit (and be eligible to use marked or "purple" fuel) the farm business must have \$10,000 or more of gross annual farm production.

### **What is the need for this consultation?**

Alberta Municipal Affairs, along with municipal and industry stakeholders, has been working on a review of the definition of farming operations. The review involves the clarification of the definition of farming operations, as well the introduction of woodlots to this definition. This review of the definition is part of the province's role in maintaining a fair and equitable system of property assessment in Alberta.
