About the Municipal Financial Assistance Program Key Dates Calendar

The Municipal Financial Assistance Programs Key Dates Calendar (calendar) has been developed as a convenient reference tool for municipal administrators applying for provincial grants. The calendar summarizes key application and reporting dates for the period January 1 to December 31, 2009 for over 70 programs and grants available to municipalities.

The calendar supplements the existing 2008/09 Municipal Financial Assistance Handbook (Handbook), available as a searchable database or downloadable file from the Alberta Municipal Affairs website at: <https://mahextranet.gov.ab.ca/mfapo/>

Using the Calendar

The calendar is organized by month, and lists by date the programs with application or reporting deadlines during the month.

Programs with multiple application or reporting dates have been identified in each of the relevant months.

Where application and reporting dates will be determined at a later date, "TBD" has been inserted. It is recommended that you follow up with program staff directly to confirm the dates.

The "Other Grant Requirements" lists grant programs that do not have specific application dates. Application requirements vary depending on the program and the conditions to be met to receive funding.

Information in the calendar was correct at the time of printing. It may differ from the Handbook and individual grant program forms or websites. Where a discrepancy arises, please contact the program directly for the most up to date information.
